She performs at prestigious venues both nationally and internationally as a solo and chamber musician. Ines has a keen interest in historical performance practice and plays a variety of period instruments including the lute, theorbo and baroque guitar.

This concert is free admission, and will be held on Sunday, November 12 at 2 pm in Fallbrook's historic Mission Theater, 231 N. Main Avenue. Theater doors open for Social Hour at 1 p.m.; concert hall doors open at 1:30 p.m., and the concert begins at 2 p.m.
